### Learn About Yourself

1. Complete all 7 assessments. To continue to the next assessment or to go back to results for a previous assessment, click the **Learn about Yourself** link

2. Once all are completed, return to each assessment and review matches by clicking on **Matching Careers** under **Actions** in lower right corner.

3. Click on any blue link to see recommended career options based on your results.

4. Once you have clicked on a career of interest, find out more information on that career by clicking on the tabs to the left of the page.

- The “**What They Do**” tab also provides related careers in the upper right corner
- The “**Is This for You?**” tab provides more information as it relates to your Interests and Values results and those for the general population of professionals in the field
